

### MADRICHIM – JOSEPH & BELLE BRAUN RELIGIOUS SCHOOL

### Who You Are:

9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grader interested in supporting our Religious School in various capacities. In addition to Anshe Emet Synagogue members, we welcome non-members to apply. We are looking for teens who are willing to learn, work on a team, and are dedicated to Anshe Emet and the students in the religious school. Available placements include: classroom support (JK-8<sup>th</sup>) and specialty madrichim (1-on-1 support, floaters, Little Builders, office, etc.). Religious school is in session Sundays 9am-12pm and Thursdays 4:15pm-6:15pm. Below is the general description for classroom support madrichim.

# As a Madrich/a you will:

- Assist teachers with weekly classroom activities and programs by engaging and participating with the students and weekly activities.
- Support the learning and success of the students by forming meaningful relationships and connections with students, teachers, and your fellow coworkers.
- Act as a role model and trusted mentor for the students in the Anshe Emet Religious school.
- Attend mandatory Madrichim specific trainings (Hadricha) and professional development sessions.
- Specialty madrichim will work with Religious School leadership to identify specific roles and responsibilities.

### **MADRICHIM EXPECTATIONS:**

- Timelines: Arrive to your classrooms by 8:30am sharp every Sunday that school is in session to help set up the classroom and be ready for the day. You will need to stay for dismissal until 12:15 every Sunday. You will need to sign in every morning in order to receive pay or service learning hours. If you need to be absent, we expect communication to Director of Education, Teen Engagement Specialist and assigned classroom teacher. We expect all madrichim to show up to all Religious School sessions, and all applicable trainings/professional development sessions.
- **Help wherever you see it is needed:** If you see a spill, get a paper towel to wipe it up. If you see a student struggling, sit near that student to provide extra support. We want you to feel empowered to be a problem solver.
- **Be aware of what is going on in the classroom:** Pay attention to the lesson and the students. You are another set of eyes in the classroom and can jump in to assist whenever necessary.
- **Cellphone rules:** Cellphones and headphones must be out of sight during class. Madrichim are responsible for communicating if requesting an exception to this rule.
- End of the day: Please assist with cleaning up the classroom after the students are gone. We also expect you to help our staff and students during dismissal to ensure all children make it to their families safely and calmly.
